Dear Sycamore Members,

**Re: Main Pool Update**

Thank you for your cooperation in making the first week of the pool opening under the Covid 19 county guidelines successful. In order to provide more opportunities to use the pool, **members are allowed a maximum of 4 reservations per week**, up from 2.

As a reminder, the main is open weekdays from 12:30 pm to 8:00 pm and weekends from 10:00 am to 8:00 pm. Members are required to make reservations in advance at the website **SycamoreHomesPool.getomnify.com** and to sign a Waiver of Liability. (Please enter SycamoreHomesPool.getomnify.com in your browser or address bar. Choose your date and reservation time. You will be prompted to create an account if you have not already done so.

**No one without a reservation will be allowed to enter the pool. Masks are required per the county order.** Due to social distancing protocol and facility constraints, there will be a maximum of 6 swim sessions available in one of the six lanes in 45 minute blocks per day (there are two one hour blocks at the end of each day).

To allow access to all, the pool will be open for general swim. There will be no separate lap hours. No Sycamore patch swimmers, children between the ages of 8 and 14 without his/her parents, will be allowed. As per the county order, no guests will be permitted and only members of the immediate household will be permitted to enter and occupy the same swim area.

The following areas will be closed: deck area/lawn/furniture/baby pool/diving board/deep end/shallow end (except for entry and exit) trellis/barbeque area/showers/drinking fountain. Members will be asked to sign a waiver of liability when registering. Members will be asked to arrive 15 minutes prior to their swim session. **Late entry is not permitted.** Members will have to exit promptly at the conclusion of the session.

Due to restrictions imposed by Contra Costa County, we are unable to open the southside pool due to social distancing constraints. We are unable to create safe socially distanced space in the southside pool.

We know that this is not an ideal situation. If and when Contra Costa County relaxes restrictions associated with COVID - 19, the Board will react appropriately.
